

Frequently Asked Questions - Holiday 2021

Is there a way to purchase gifts on-line and have them sent directly to Emmaus?

YES! This year due to the ongoing Covid-19 crisis, Emmaus has created a wish list registry at Target.com. Instead of assigning specific families to donors, all wish list items from our families will be found on our registry at Target. Donors will be able to go to the registry and make their purchases and have them sent directly to Emmaus. No need to go to a store or drop off the items. Is it ok to donate money to Emmaus instead of buying gifts?

Yes. Emmaus sponsors our annual "Tree of Love" campaign to raise critically needed funds that support our programs throughout the year. The Tree of Love will be on display in front of the Emmaus Family House located at 150 How Street in Haverhill. We hope that the Emmaus tree will brighten up the neighborhood during these challenging times.

Contributing to the "Tree of Love" is a great way to acknowledge and/or remember those who mean a lot to you. Each \$10 gift will symbolically light one candle on the tree. Gifts can be made in honor or memory of your friends and loved ones. If you wish to make contributions in lieu of giving holiday gifts, Emmaus will provide you with acknowledgement cards to give to your family members and friends. NOTE: If you wish to receive acknowledgement cards, donations must be received by December 17th to insure delivery of the cards by 12/24/21. Can we meet the family/individual we purchase gifts for?

As an agency that serves families who are coping with complex issues, it is our responsibility by law to protect the identity of the families we serve. In the interest of client and donor confidentiality, we do not allow sponsors to meet our families. Also, we like to let parents experience the joy of giving gifts to their children and the opportunity to honor their own family traditions.

Should we wrap the gifts?

You may use gift bags/tissue paper but we ask that you *do not wrap the gifts*.

Please tag each gift and specify the item/gender/size.

How much should we get for individuals?

We ask that you purchase gifts whose values generally do not exceed \$25.

Can I just send in gift cards?

Yes! In fact, we prefer gift cards in denominations of up to \$25 per card. They are particularly helpful so that needed items can be purchased up to the last minute. Suggested stores: Target, Market Basket, Wal-Mart, Walgreens, CVS, Marshalls, Burlington Coat Factory.

Can I conduct a used coat/winter item drive?

Due to the ongoing risk of the Coronavirus, Emmaus will not be accepting any used coats this year. If you would like to purchase a new coat for one of our clients, please see our Holiday Gift Registry at target.com to see a list of our current needs. Items can be purchased and sent directly to Emmaus from the registry website.

Are my donations tax deductible?

Emmaus is happy to acknowledge donations for tax purposes. However, current IRS regulations prohibit us from including a monetary value of the donation on our acknowledgement letter. We will provide a description of your donation on our letter, but in order for you to receive tax credit for your donation; you should retain receipts for the items or gift cards you purchase. These receipts, attached to the acknowledgement letter that we will send to you after the holiday, can be submitted to your tax preparer. In a nutshell, if you are planning to submit your donation for tax credit, be sure to save your receipts!

Will your recipients be notified who donated their gifts?

Yes! We appreciate the support from our community during the holiday season and encourage our residents to learn more about our donors. You may identify yourself by including your church, group or organization's name; however, we ask that you please do not provide your personal information or **advertise** for your church, group or organization.
